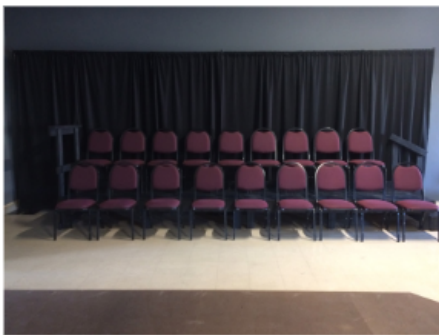
Changing Faces Theater Company

Further Costs for Theater Space

(All Costs Are Estimates)



- Annual storage cost (Due July 1): \$2400
- More lighting equipment: \$1000
- Supplies, repairs and/or painting for 3 bathrooms: \$1500
- Completion of theater lobby--desk, plaques, decorations: \$2000
- Backstage side masking, tech booth construction, materials: \$3000

TOTAL IMMEDIATE REMAINING COSTS:
\$9900.00

This above amount does NOT include the monthly rent of \$1680, monthly utilities of about \$100, or miscellaneous costs that arise.
